Recipients will be notified no later than MAY 30, 2024.

# The JoElla Haynes Julien Scholarship - Four \$750.00 Scholarships

The JoElla Haynes Julien Scholarship will be awarded to 4 African-American (US citizens) graduating high school female students residing in Southern Nevada who will attend a college or university fall 2023. These scholarships are awarded based on the recipients' academic achievement, community involvement, extra-curricular activities, and financial need.

Requirements:

- 1. Reside in Southern Nevada
- 2. Black/African-American
- 3. Female
- 4. Graduating High School Senior
- 5. Have a minimum overall 3.0 overall GPA and a minimum 3.0 fall semester GPA
- 6. Evidence of extra-curricular activities and/or community service
- 7. 500-word essay that discusses the importance of giving back and helping others
- 8. Three (3) letters of recommendation
- 9. Official high school transcript
- 10. Statement of financial need

### The Tamela D. Ketchmore Scholarship - One \$1500.00 Scholarship

The Tamela D. Ketchmore Scholarship will be awarded to 1 African-American (US citizen) graduating high school female student residing in Southern Nevada who will attend a college or university fall 2023. Applicants must be the child or grandchild of an active-duty military service member or veteran. This scholarship will be awarded based on the recipients' academic achievement, community involvement, extra-curricular activities, and financial need. Requirements:

- 1. Reside in Southern Nevada
- 2. Black/African-American
- 3. Female
- 4. Graduating High School Senior

- 5. Have a minimum overall 3.0 overall GPA and a minimum 3.0 fall semester GPA
- 6. Evidence of extra-curricular activities and/or community service
- 7. Child or grandchild of a veteran or active duty service member
- 8. 500-word essay that discusses the importance of promoting social change and development, and the empowerment of people and communities.
- 9. Three (3) letters of recommendation
- 10. Official high school transcript
- 11. Statement of financial need

# The TPOHF HBCU - One \$500 Scholarship

The scholarship will be awarded to 1 high school student residing in Southern Nevada who will attend an HBCU fall 2023. This merit-based scholarship is will be awarded based on need, and the applicant's academic achievement, community involvement, and extra-curricular activities.

Requirements:

- 1. Reside in Southern Nevada
- 2. Graduating High School Senior
- 3. Have a minimum overall cumulative GPA of at least a 3.0 for the merit-based

scholarship and a 2.5 for the need-based scholarship.

4. Evidence of extra-curricular activities and/or community service

5. 500-word essay that discusses a famous or well-known HBCU graduate highlighting their contributions to society or their community and how their contributions have impacted you directly or indirectly.

- 6. Three (3) letters of recommendation
- 7. Official high school transcript
- 8. Statement of financial need

# The TPOHF Scholarship - One \$1000.00 Scholarship

The TPOHF Scholarship will be awarded to 1 graduating high school student who will attend a two- or four-year colleges/universities and/or vocational/technical full-time. The applicant's academic achievement, community involvement, extra-curricular activities, and financial need will be considered.

### Requirements:

- 1. Reside in Southern Nevada
- 2. Graduating High School Senior
- 3. GPA Requirement: Minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA and Minimum 2.5 semester GPA
- 4. Evidence of extra-curricular activities and/or community service
- 5. 500-word personal statement
- 6. Three (3) letters of recommendation
- 7. Official high school transcript
- 8. Statement of financial need


